The Limited Liability Company (LLC) is a new entity that allows flexible management like a general partnership, but without personal liability for its members like a corporation.

Because LLC's are relatively new creations, there are not a lot of answers to legal question that may arise.

Unlike general partnerships or individuals, LLC are subject to Texas Franchise tax like the corporations.

States have their laws and the IRS of the U.S Department of Treasury has its rules and regulations. The state's jurisdiction authorizes a Limited Liability Company (LLC) to conduct business like a corporation within the state. This consent has nothing to do with the various definitions of 'taxpayer' as used by the IRS. The IRS taxed the LLC as a partnership or sole proprietorship but not as a incorporated entity unless the LLC requests a special ruling to the IRS.

A corporation may elect to be taxed like a partnership (S Corporation), Further in contrast to an S corporation, an LLC may have different classes of ownership and an unlimited number of members, who do not have to be individuals or residents of the United States. The LLC members must pay Social Security tax on its profits, whereas S Corporations profits are exempt from social Security Tax.

Time taken: 2 days to organize and to obtain a Federal Employer Identification number (EIN). A LLC may be formed by one or more natural persons of the age of eighteen years or by any partnership, corporation, association, trust, or estate.

(1) The state law requires to have at least one member and one manager or only one Member-manager. The LLC may have officers. The state law does not impose residency requirements on members, managers or officers. They not need to reside or be domiciled in Texas.

(2) A name and address of registered agent who is at the registered office address is required to organize. The registered agent shall be a Texas resident domiciled in Texas. A LLC may be dissolved involuntary if failed to maintain a registered agent in Texas.

(3) As soon as possible after the Certification of Organization is filed, the LLC must apply for a Federal Employer Identification Number (EIN) filling out IRS Form SS-4. All the members of the LLC shall have a EIN, Social Security number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number ITIN, and at least the number of one member must be included on the form

SS-4. To obtain a ITIN an original birth certificate and copies of passport, U.S. visa, and driver license certified by U.S Consul or U.S. Notary Public is required.

(4) LLCs subject to state sales or use taxes must apply for a seller's permit. Wholesalers as well as retailers, must obtain a permit. A Wholesaler, however, is not required to collect sales tax from retailers who holds a valid permit and who buys for resale.

PLEASE NOTE:

The state of Texas requires different businesses and occupations (like alcoholic beverages, professionals) to obtain licenses. So far few businesses (like radio stations, motor freight lines, etc) require federal permits. U.S. Businesses that own certain real property and are controllers by foreigners are required to file federal reports.
